Place of the Spanish Course:	The residence of Host. Host holds an MA in Linguistics. The residence is near beautiful white sand beaches and a tranquil ocean. La Paz is a small, quiet town with friendly people. There are nice restaurants, museums, pubs, and great shopping to practice your Spanish!
Location:	La Paz, BCS, Mexico
Duration:	One week or Two week courses
Fee includes: -transportation from La Paz International Airport to Host's home (day 1) and from Host's home to La Paz International Airport (on day 7/14) -accommodations : bedroom and bathroom, WIFI, swimming pool (see photos below) -breakfast* and dinner/comida** shared with Host and family -4 hours of daily instruction, tailored to student's level, including grammar, culture, diction, speaking, reading, and writing -tours to local places of interest, as time/weather allows***	Fees: 7 day course: \$1,750 US dollars paid to PTS of SV (individual room) \$1,500 US dollars paid to PTS of SV (shared bedroom with another student, preferably a friend of the student) 14 day course: \$2,750 US dollars paid to PTS of SV (individual room) \$2,500 US dollars paid to PTS of SV (shared bedroom with another student, preferably a friend of the student) Check, cash, or credit card, paid in full 2 weeks before departure. \$250 fine for cancellations 7 to 14 days before departure, no refunds after that.
